TOLLER PORCORUM VILLAGE HALL TRUSTEES BBQ SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE HIRER

In the interests of the safety of the hirer and his/her group, the Village Hall neighbours and to comply with the Trustees' Insurance Policy, these instructions must be followed.

- 1. Check with the booking Clerk the whereabouts of the grill and charcoal plate at the time of booking. For safety reasons these items must be used as they fit the brick barbecue structure exactly.
- 2. Check with the booking Clerk the whereabouts of the utensils. However, you may bring your own.
- 3. You are required to bring your own charcoal. Use only enough charcoal to cover the base of the BBQ. Only approved charcoal (as purchased from a VAT registered outlet). No other fuel is permitted.
- 4. Use approved BBQ lighter fuel or firelighters to start the BBQ. Never use petrol, paraffin or biofuel.
- 5. Before lighting the BBQ you must have a bucket of water nearby, (this will be provided along with the charcoal plate and grill). You must also have located the whereabouts of the nearest fire extinguisher (to be found inside the Hall).
- 6. Instruct any children in your group that they must keep away from the BBQ.
- 7. After cooking, please leave the remains of the charcoal plate and the grill in place. Do not leave the site until all the ashes look grey or white. YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO EMPTY THE TRAY OR CLEAN THE GRILL (it is included in the charge!).
